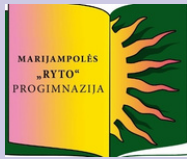

## ABOUT THE PROJECT

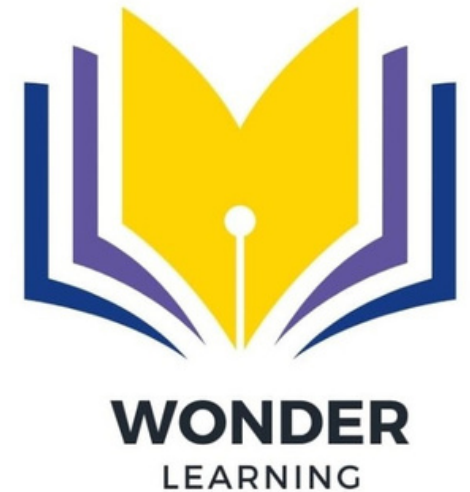
